



Research Assistant / Lab Manager Position

Overview: A full-time research position in the Kuhl Lab at the University of Oregon is available starting summer/fall 2018 (start date flexible). The lab uses behavioral and neuroimaging methods (e.g., fMRI, EEG) to study the cognitive neuroscience of memory, cognitive control,



and attention. These topics are addressed using cutting-edge methods (multivariate pattern analysis, brain-based decoding and stimulus reconstruction). The lab and PI's office are located in the Lewis Integrative Science Building (pictured left). The lab benefits from convenient access to EEG facilities and a Siemens Skyra 3T MRI system (all housed within the Lewis Building). There are also substantial opportunities for interaction with other cognitive and systems neuroscience labs within the Institute for Neuroscience. For more information about the

Job responsibilities: Contribute to behavioral, fMRI, and EEG data collection, assist with experimental design and preparation, perform data analyses, oversee subject recruitment and IRB protocols, supervise and train undergraduate research assistants, and maintain lab computers and software.

Qualifications: College degree required (prior to start date). Strong interpersonal and organization skills required. Prior research experience and/or strong computer skills strongly preferred. In particular, experience with computer programming (e.g., Matlab or Python) is desirable. Experience with fMRI research is a plus, but not required. An interest in pursuing a career in cognitive neuroscience and a two-year commitment are preferred.
